2.Marian Computer Lab Rules

- 1. Computer lab is the common property of the college.
- 2. The lab will normally be open from 8 am to 5 pm and 6 pm to 10 pm on all days except Saturday afternoon, Sundays and other public holidays.

- 4. Once you log on to a computer, do not change the system without permission.
