

1. Malala day celebration





2. Anti Plastic Day



3. Youth Skills Day Celebration






4. Nelson Mandela Day Celebration



74th Independence Day celebrations were organized. Students shared Independence Day messages through posters, videos and photo collages.



7. Hiroshima-Nagasaki Day

12. Rainy Day Celebration





13. A mini marathon organized on the occasion of 75th Independence Day









18.Puneet Agar Abhiyan





19. Fundraising For The We-Care Fund






28. **HIV awareness programme**


Achievements


1. Firing Camp 2022


4. EBSB II KANNUR :



Advanced Leadership Camp was attended by CQMS Liyamol Lalan in the year 2021. The camp took place in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.


Extra Achievement



4. National Karate Championship 2023
