Governing Board (2023 & 2024)

Marian Alumni Association Kuttikkanam

The installation ceremony of the Governing Board for the years 2023 & 2024 of Marian Alumni Association Kuttikkanam was conducted at the Conference hall of Marian College Kuttikkanam on 21st January 2023.

The event commenced at 11.00 am with Ms. Aksa Ann Thomas welcoming the gathering.

The meeting was presided over by Mr. Binoy Mathew (President) who called the formal meeting to order. Formal meeting began with a prayer song by Ms. Melby Joseph (Treasurer - Elect). Mr. Aju Varghese (Joint Secretary – Elect) delivered the welcome address.

The dignitaries on the dais were Mr. Binoy Mathew (President), Prof. Dr. Ajimon George (Principal), Adv. Nelson Joseph (President -Elect), Ms. Jyothi Jose (Secretary) and Mr. Aju Varghese (Joint Secretary - Elect).

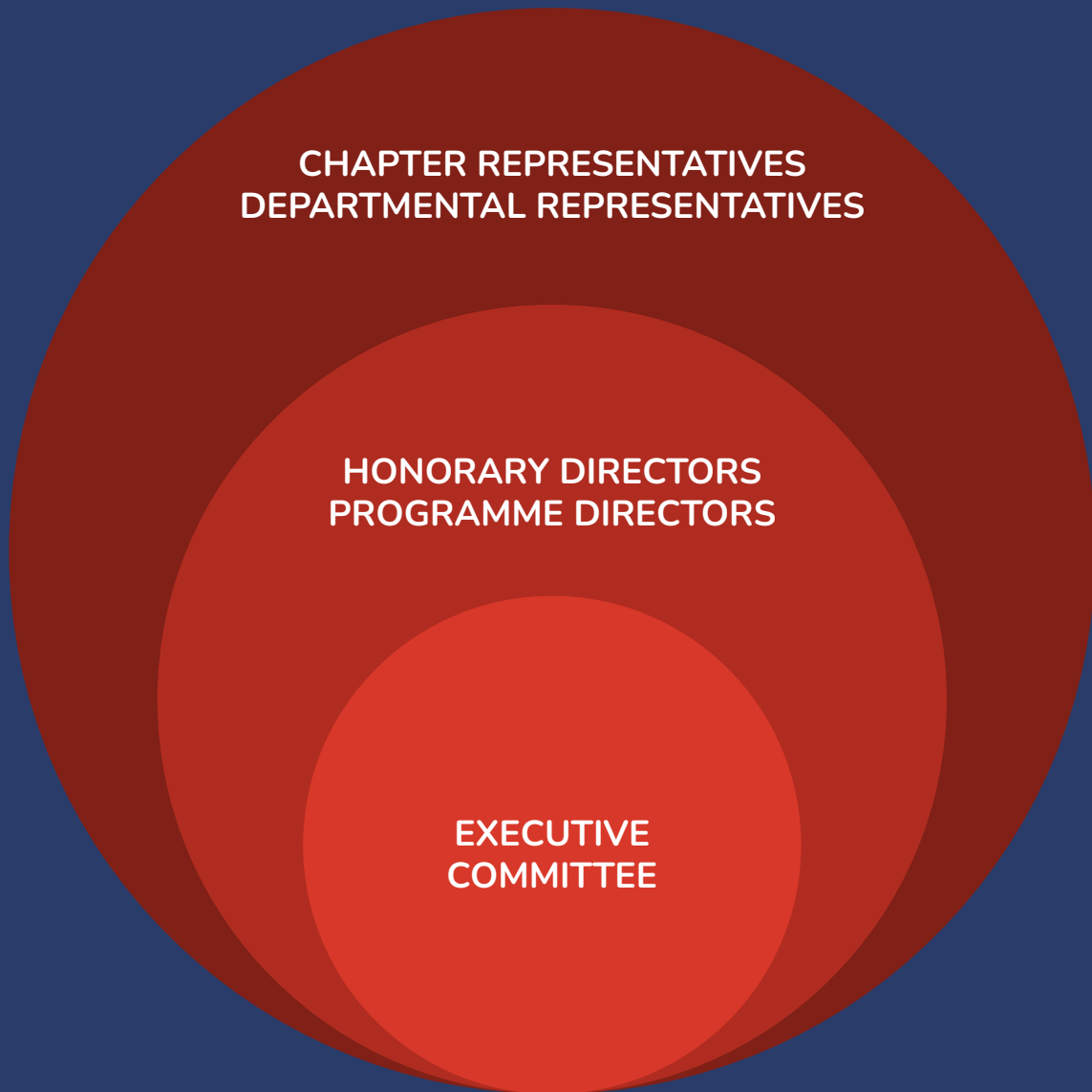
