

NOTIFICATION

Marian College extends a warm and heartfelt welcome to all first-year students to the Marian Campus.

It is hereby notified that the classes for all the first year Four Year Under Graduate Programmes (FYUGP) are scheduled to commence at 10 am on 01st July 2024 (Monday).

The classes will commence at 10 am with an Inaugural function in the MAGIS auditorium of the College.

The following guidelines are issued for compliance by students who are admitted to the first year FYUGP.

- 1. All the students and the parents are expected to be present for the inaugural function.
- 2. All students (both hostellers and day scholars) and parents are required to be seated in the venue of the inaugural function (MAGIS Auditorium) at 9.45 am.
- 3. Students who have either already reserved or are planning to reserve their rooms in SH Hostel, Amala Hostel and those who have booked and paid the fees online for Paul Iby Men's Hostel, MaryKnoll Men's Hostel and Madonna Ladies Hostel should report to their respective hostels to move in on Monday, July 1, 2024. They should be accompanied by their parents/ guardians. The hostel rooms will be available for occupancy from 7:30 am to 9:30 am and again after the inaugural function. Admit cards for those who booked hostel online on 25/6/2024 will be accessible in the login page by June 28, including assigned floor and room numbers. Please present a copy of your admit card at the front office of the hostel to ensure seamless entry into your designated room.
- 4. Upon arrival at their designated hostels, students will be guided to their assigned rooms. Students and parents who have not yet had the opportunity to meet the Hostel Wardens must do so on July 1, 2024. Those who have already met with the Hostel Wardens do not need to meet them again.
- 5. Due to the high number of applicants for hostel accommodations this year, priority will be given to students living more than 40 kilometers away from the College during the initial stage. Students residing within a 40-kilometer radius will be considered for accommodation only after classes have commenced and this will be based on the availability of rooms at that time.

6. Students are not permitted to stay in private rented houses/apartments.

7. Students shall follow the guidelines for admission to hostels provided in the College website.

8. All students are required to bring a stamp-sized photograph on July 1, 2024 for the

issuance of their temporary College ID card. These temporary ID cards will be

distributed in their respective classrooms on July 2, 2024 and can be used until the

official College ID cards are issued.

9. Starting from July 1, 2024 students must adhere to the College's uniform policy and are

prohibited from wearing casual dress on campus. The College uniform must be worn

as per the specified norms set by the institution. It is mandatory to strictly follow the

prescribed pattern of the uniform and any alterations/ modifications to conform to

fashion trends are not permitted.

10. The dress code is applicable outside class hours and on holidays also. Casual dress is

permitted inside the hostels only.

11. Students are expected to maintain a dignified and respectful appearance in their attire

whenever they are not required to wear uniforms. It is crucial to adhere strictly to the

grooming standards set by Marian College.

12. The Honorable Chief Minister of Kerala will inaugurate the state level implementation

of FYUGP on 1st July 2024 at 12 pm at Government Women's College,

Thiruvananthapuram. There will be live streaming of this function from 12 pm onwards

in the MAGIS Auditorium.

13. July 3, 2024 being St. Thomas Day is a holiday for the College. Students have the

freedom to go home on July 2, 2024 after the class hours and report on July 4, 2024

at 8.30 for the classes.

14. The class schedule for FYUGP will be communicated once the College timetable is

finalized, taking into account Minors, Multi-Disciplinary courses, Ability

Enhancement courses and other relevant factors. However, classes will start at 8.30

am on all working days.
