

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Welcome to Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous) where excellence meets opportunity.

Admission to various academic programs at Marian will adhere to the eligibility criteria prescribed by **Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam**. From the academic year 2024-2025, the University has introduced **Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP)**. The eligibility requirements for undergraduate admissions are alignment with the University regulations. For detailed information on admission requirements and eligibility criteria for undergraduate and postgraduate programs, please refer to the relevant admission prospectuses.

Follow this step-by-step guide to complete your admission process successfully for **undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programs**.

STEP 1: UNDERSTAND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Before starting your application, ensure you meet the specific eligibility requirements for your chosen program.

Eligibility

Undergraduate Programs

- Candidates must have completed 10+2 (Higher Secondary) or equivalent examination with the required minimum marks/ grade as specified by Mahatma Gandhi University.
- Specific subject and percentage requirements depend on the program.

Postgraduate Programs

- A Bachelor's degree in the relevant discipline with a minimum percentage (refer to the course-specific guidelines).
- Additional entrance tests or qualifications may be required for certain programs.

Doctoral Programs

- A Master's degree in the relevant discipline with at least 55% aggregate marks/ equivalent grade.
- Must qualify UGC-NET or other recognized entrance tests (if applicable).

STEP 2: REGISTRATION AND APPLICATION SUBMISSION

1. Online Registration

- Visit the official website of Marian College: www.mariancollege.org.
- Navigate to the “Admissions” section and click on “Apply Online.”
- Register using a valid email ID and phone number. You will receive login credentials via email.

2. Fill Out Application Form

- Log in to the portal and complete the application form.
- Provide accurate details, including:
 - Personal information (name, date of birth, contact details, etc.).
 - Educational qualifications (10th and 12th marks, board and, year of passing).
 - Preferred programs.

3. Upload the following documents:

- Recent passport-size photograph.
- 10th and 12th mark sheets (UG programs)
- Mark sheets and degree certificates for PG/Ph.D. applicants.
- Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate.
- Community Certificate (if applicable).
- Income certificate (For candidates eligible for fee concession)

4. Pay the Application Fee:

Payment can be made via net banking, debit/credit cards, or UPI.

STEP 3: SELECTION PROCESS

- Admission is based on academic performance in the qualifying examination.
- A rank list will be published after application review.
- Reservation policies are followed as per Government norms.

- Applicants under specific quotas (e.g., sports, cultural, persons with disabilities) must provide appropriate certificates.
- The admission procedure for International Students is conducted online, allowing them to apply from their home countries. Physical presence in India is required only upon shortlisting for the chosen program.
- **For Programs Requiring Entrance Tests/Interviews:** The schedule will be notified via website.

STEP 4: PUBLICATION OF RANK LIST

- The rank list will be published on the official website of the College and in the application portal.
- Selected candidates will also receive a provisional Allotment Memo via email with the details of the next steps, such as document verification and fee payment.

STEP 5: DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

Candidates must report to the College for document verification with:

Original Documents:

- 10th, 12th and graduation certificates (if applicable).
- Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
- Migration Certificate (if applicable).
- Eligibility Certificate (if required)
- Community/Reservation Certificate (if applicable).
- Aadhaar Card

Photocopies:

- Two copies of all original documents.

Photograph:

- Recent passport-size photographs.

STEP 6: FEE PAYMENT

- Pay the admission fee as outlined in the Provisional Allotment Memo.
- Payment options include net banking, credit/debit cards, or UPI.
- Retain the payment receipt for future reference.

STEP 7: CONFIRMATION OF ADMISSION

After document verification and fee payment, candidates will receive an **Admission Confirmation Letter**.
