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# KIFF 2024: Celebrating Women's Empowerment Through Cinema

The 7th Kuttikannam International Film Festival (KIFF) was held on November 14 and 15 at Marian College Kuttikkanam, organized by the Department of Communication and Media Studies and the Medios Talkies Film Society, in collaboration with the Kerala State Chalachitra Academy and the Federation of Film Societies of India (Kerala).

The festival, themed "SHE" (Stories of Her Empowerment) is focused on women-centered cinema. It was inaugurated by Malayalam film star Vincy Aloshious. The meeting presided over by Principal Prof. Dr. Ajimon George and felicitated by prominent speakers, including Peermade MLA Shri. Vazhoor Soman. The event included an Open Forum, Master Class, and exhibitions on photography and film production. The Cultural Evening featured performances by Malayalam film industry guests Sharaf U Dheen, Adhri Joe, Joemon Jyothir, Ganga Meera, and Sruthy Suresh.

On November 15, an Open Forum addressed "Challenges and Discrimination Faced by Women in the Workplace". Ratheena PT, director of the Malayalam film Puzhu (2022), was the chief guest. The discussion was moderated by Anson Thomas, with panelists Ajesh Parackal, Simi John, Malavika Ramadevi, and Dr. MA Vijeesh. The festival showcased 10 films from various countries, focusing on women's struggles for survival.

Competitions for short films and documentaries were held, with winners receiving cash prizes and certificates. KIFF has been an important platform for addressing social issues through cinema, with past editions focusing on topics such as environmental protection, censorship, marginalized communities, pandemic recovery, love, and life after war.

The festival was led by Patron Prof. M. Vijayakumar, Festival Director Fr. Sobi Thomas, Artistic Director Anson Thomas, and student coordinators - Aishwarya Lakshmi M.S., Ajin Jiji, and Anjal.

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# Open Forum on "SHE" Highlights Women's Resilience and Workplace Challenges



The Department of Communication and Media Studies successfully conducted an Open Forum as part of the SHE 2024 theme, focusing on women's empowerment. The event featured a panel of distinguished guests and speakers, including filmmaker Ratheena PT as the chief guest, Anson Thomas as the moderator, and discussants Ajesh Parackal, Simi John, Malavika Ramadevi, and Dr. MA Vijeesh. The primary discussion revolved around the challenges women face in the workplace and the discrimination thev often encounter. The forum also highlighted inspiring stories of women overcoming adversity to achieve success in their fields.

Chief Guest Ratheena PT delivered a powerful talk, sharing her personal journey of overcoming life's challenges to establish herself as a successfilmmaker. Speaking candidly about her struggles, she described how she rose above the difficulties that once enslaved her, turning obstacles into stepping stones. Ratheena emphasized that success is achievable when one embraces responsibilities with confidence and clarity of purpose



Drawing on her own experiences, Ratheena praised the role of mothers as exemplary figures of responsibility. She eloquently highlighted how mothers tirelessly manage their households, waking early and working late into the night, often without recognition. "If a mother can handle all the responsibilities within a family, how can anyone claim that women cannot take on responsibilities elsewhere?" asked. Her speech inspired the audience to reflect on the immense potential women possess and the determination required to achieve their dreams despite societal challenges.

Simi John provided insights into the global challenges faced by women in the workplace.

She highlighted that, despite 180 million women being employed across various sectors, they often face harassment and discrimination, with many remaining silent due to societal pressure and fear of isolation. Ajesh Parackal emphasized the disparity in leadership roles, noting that while women actively participate and excel in college programs, men disproportionately hold positions of authorreflecting deep-rooted gender biases and societal inequities.

Dr. MA Vijeesh praised the classic film Neelakuyil for its sensitive and artistic portrayal of themes aligned with SHE 2024. He emphasized the importance of promoting gender equality and urged the audience to recognize the

additional effort women must exert to achieve parity with men in various sectors. Malavika Ramadevi supported this notion, noting that women often need to work 20% harder than men to reach the same level of recognition and success.

The forum concluded with a unanimous call to action: the need to stand united against gender discrimination and societal injustices. "If we do not stand with justice, we are, by default, supporting injustice," the panel emphasized. Participants and speakers urged the audience to build a society free from gender biases, where equal opportunities and respect prevail for all. The Open Forum served as a thought-provoking platform to discuss the challenges women face, celebrate their achievements, and envision a future of equality. It left attendees inspired to contribute toward creating a more inclusive and fair society.


