



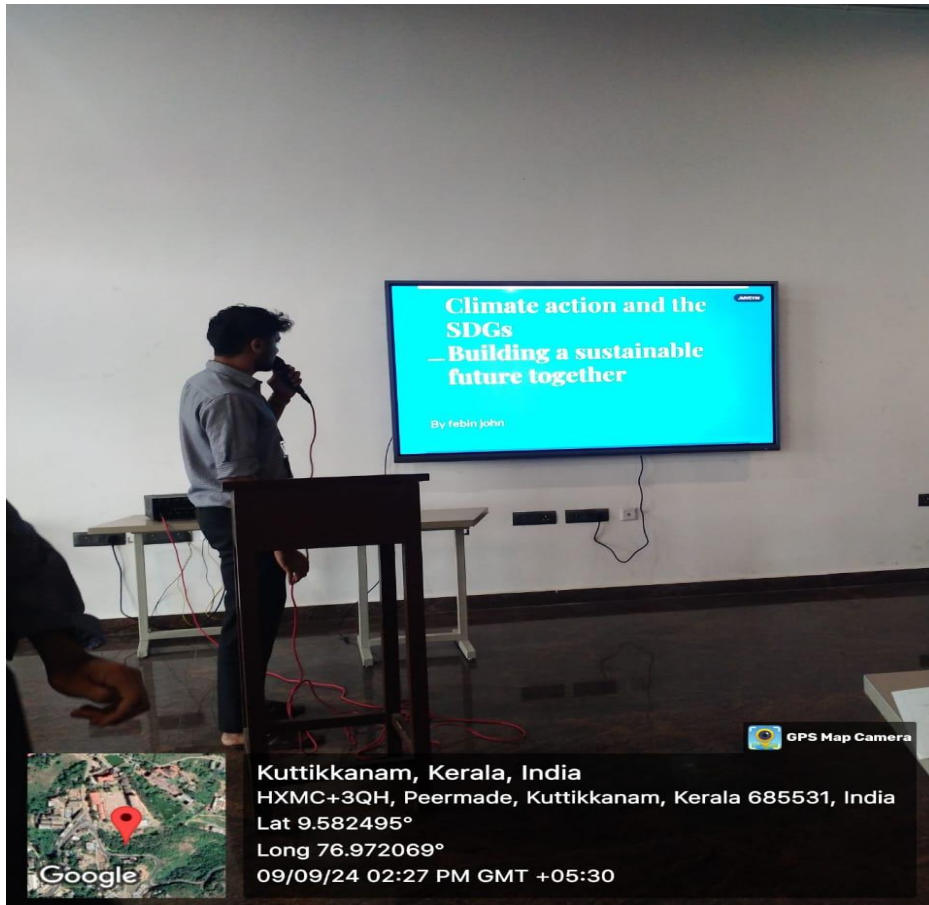

- Setting up of stalls



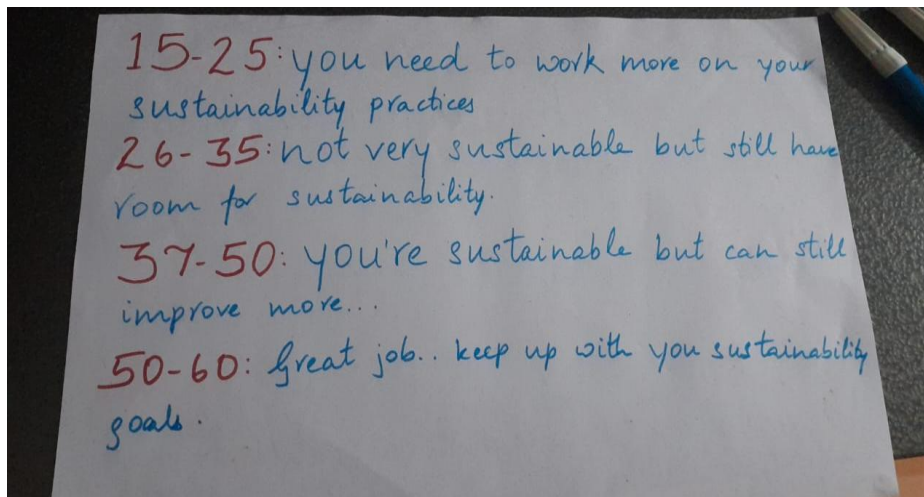

5. **Keynote Address:** Smt. Geethakumari S., District Women and Child Development Officer, Idukki, delivered the keynote address. She stressed the need for coordinated efforts among stakeholders to create a safer environment for women.
6. **Felicitation:** Eminent dignitaries, including Prof. Dr. Ajimon George, Principal of Marian College Kuttikkanam, and Sri. Vishal Johnson, were felicitated for their valuable contributions to the cause.
7. **Vote of Thanks:** Ms. Subitha Parameswaran, District Coordinator, DHEW Idukki, extended a heartfelt vote of thanks, expressing gratitude to the organizers, participants, and attendees for making the event a success.

## Visit to Tropical Institute of Ecological Sciences (TIES)

**Date:** 16/12/2024

As part of the initiatives under the collaboration between UNAI and the Marian Research Centre for Sustainable Development, a field visit to the Tropical Institute of Ecological Sciences (TIES) was organized on 16 December 2024. The visit was conducted as a follow-up to the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed earlier this academic year between Marian College and TIES.

A team of 42 students and four faculty members, led by Dr. T. V. Muralivallabhan, participated in the program. The students engaged in hands-on training and experiential learning activities designed to introduce them to sustainable practices and environmental conservation techniques. This immersive experience provided valuable insights into various research activities and conservation strategies.

During the visit, the students were exposed to the following practices and techniques:

- Apiculture (bee-keeping)
- Vermicomposting
- Fish farming
- Sustainable architecture
- Water and energy conservation methods
- Soil preservation techniques

The visit was facilitated by Marian College, which arranged transportation for the participants. The total expense for lunch, amounting to **Rs. 4200**, was contributed by the students. In addition, tea and snacks were provided twice to all participants during the program.

At the end of the session, students were awarded certificates by TIES in recognition of their participation.

The visit proved to be an enriching experience, helping students to better understand and appreciate sustainable development practices while fostering an interest in environmental research and conservation efforts opening up opportunity for students to take up internship and research at TIES.
