

NOTIFICATION

Marian College extends a warm and heartfelt welcome to all first-year students as they join the Marian Campus.

This is to inform all students admitted to the First Year Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGP)/Integrated PG Programme that classes will commence at **10:00 AM on Wednesday, 1st July 2026.**

The academic session will begin with an Inaugural Function at 10:00 AM in the MAGIS Auditorium of the College.

All newly admitted FYUGP students are required to adhere to the following guidelines.

- 1. All the students, both hostellers and day scholar along with their parents are expected to be present for the inaugural function at MAGIS Auditorium, by 9:45 AM.**
2. Students admitted to various hostels may report to their respective hostels on Tuesday, June 30, 2026, or Wednesday, July 1, 2026, and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Hostel rooms will be available for occupancy from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM on June 30, and from 7:30 AM to 9:30 AM on July 1, and again after the inaugural function. **However, both parents and students are required to be present and participate in the inaugural function scheduled on July 1, 2026, irrespective of whether they take admission on June 30.** Admit cards for students who completed online hostel booking on June 27, 2026 will be accessible through the login portal and will include the assigned floor and room numbers. Students are required to present a printed copy of their admit card at the hostel front office to ensure smooth entry into their designated rooms.
3. Upon arrival at their designated hostels, students will be guided to their assigned rooms. Students and parents who have not yet met the Hostel Wardens are required to do so on June 30, 2026, or July 1, 2026. Those who have already met the Wardens need not meet them again.
4. Due to the high volume of applications for hostel accommodation this year, priority will initially be given to students residing more than 40 kilometers from the College. Students living within a 40-kilometer radius will be considered for accommodation only after the

- commencement of classes, subject to the availability of rooms at that time.
5. Students are not permitted to reside in privately rented houses or apartments.
 6. Students are required to follow the hostel guidelines available on the College website. For detailed information, please refer to the hostel guidelines at the following link: <https://mariancollege.org/wp-content/uploads/2026/06/Hostel-Guidelines-2026-27.pdf>
 7. Effective July 1, 2026, all students are required to adhere strictly to the College's uniform policy and are not permitted to wear casual attire on campus. The prescribed College uniform must be worn in accordance with the guidelines set by the institution. Any alterations or modifications made to align with fashion trends are strictly prohibited.
 8. The dress code is applicable at all times including outside class hours and on holidays. Casual attire is permitted only within the premises of the hostels.
 9. Students are expected to maintain a dignified and respectful appearance in their attire whenever uniforms are not required. Adherence to the grooming standards set by Marian College is mandatory.  10. Friday July 3, 2026 will be a holiday in observance of St. Thomas Day. Students may leave for home after class hours on Thursday July 2, 2026 and are expected to report back by 8:30 AM on Monday, July 6 2026 for regular classes.
 11. The class schedule for FYUGP will be communicated after the commencement of classes. On all working days, classes will begin at 8:30 AM and may extend until 4:30 PM, depending on academic requirements.
